

Al KARMA For Paper Industries manufacturing and producing Kraftliner, Testliner and Fluting paper is committed to the principles promoted by the Forest Stewardship Council of environmentally appropriate, socially beneficial and economically viable management of forests. To achieve FSC objectives a comprehensive management system is in place to ensure:

- Issues are identified through plantation planning and management processes;
- An effective community consultation process is implemented including complaints resolution and feedback processes;
- Involvement and input of workers is valued; and
- Effective monitoring and auditing processes are in place to confirm standards and values are being met and to provide the basis for continual improvement.

Al KARMA For Paper Industries manufacturing and producing Kraftliner, Testliner and Fluting paper is committed to identifying the source of all wood used as an input to its 'volume credit account' and in the manufacture of its FSC - labelled product. Al KARMA For Paper Industries manufacturing and producing Kraftliner, Testliner and Fluting paper takes all reasonable measures to ensure that we do not purchase:-

- Timber that has been illegally harvested;
- Timber from genetically modified trees;
- Timber from areas where traditional or civil rights are violated;
- Timber from uncertified high conservation value forests or from endangered forests; and
- Timber from natural forest that has been converted to plantations or non-forest use.

Any claims that wood being purchased by Al KARMA for manufacturing & producing Kraftliner, Testliner and Fluting paper from unacceptable sites will be formally investigated. A Complaints Log will be maintained to confirm the complaints made and actions taken.
